Chatham beat Taconic Hills Titans 11-4 on Friday at Chatham HS after a seven-run rally in the sixth inning. Four of Chatham's runs were scored off the bat of Craig Hall, who went 3-4 with 4 RBI and 2 runs scored. Craig Hall homered in the first inning, singled in the third inning, and doubled in the sixth inning. Cole Gleason was also 2 for 4 with 2 runs scored and Tanner Niles was 2 for 3. Craig Hall also went six strong innings and kept the ball around the plate, as he threw strikes on 52 of his 92 pitches. Hall struck out five and walked three for Chatham. He had a lot of baserunners the first few innings and did a great job of battling through it and minimizing the damage allowing just 1 in the first when the Titans loaded the bases with no outs and then getting out of another bases loaded jam in the 2nd. He stranded 2 more runners in the 3rd and then hit his groove for the next three innings. Cody Hall pitched the 7th inning to close out the game.

For Taconic, Zack Ernst, Gage Arcuri and Dylan Dotterer each had two hits to pace the hard hitting Titans team. Brian Ostrander went 5 innings for the Titans allowing 5 runs, on 5 walks, 6 hits and a strikeout. Ron Ernst and Dylan Dotterer combined to pitch the other frame allowing 6 runs on 6 hits. The game was much closer than the final score reflected. Taconic hit the ball well today and put a lot of pressure on us. Brad Doty made a great defensive play at the fence and executed a good sacrifice bunt (that turned into a hit) in the bottom of the 6th to get the rally going. Evan Young also laid down a good bunt in the inning.

I am proud of the way we have pitched and played defense over the last week. We are gelling in those areas and they will keep us in games when we play a strong team like Taconic. Chatham's record is now 13-4 overall and 8-3 in league. Taconic Hills is 8-6 overall and 6-5 in league. Coach Lagonia has them playing good ball and we expect another good game at their place on Monday.
